68 New Community Members



At the start of the new term in September the Centre registered 68 new people at the Centre who will now have access to our full timetable of classes, casework support, and financial assistance. Our community of 214 people is working to build a new life in the UK and the Centre is proud to be a hub of welcome, support, and friendship. We love to see our community grow!

NEW In-person Day Each Week



This term we started a NEW English class on Thursdays at our third site in Islington! We've loved seeing so many in our community coming out to improve their language skills through interactive activities and fun conversations. Additionally, referrals and signposting appointments are available as well as a relaxing space to chat over a warm drink and snacks with friends.

Welcome New Staff



At the start of the term we welcomed two new staff to our team! Robina Dam [pictured left] is a highly experienced English teacher. She joins our team as the English Language Coordinator, overseeing all 20+ English classes online and in-person at the Centre every week. Martha Gartside-Mitchell [pictured right] joins as Support Service Caseworker. Along with the Support Service team, she provides one-to-one casework on housing, healthcare, legal support, and more.

Joseph's Story



Joseph has been a member of the Islington Centre community for a few years. He has participated in many activities and through the Support Service has accessed support with housing and financial hardship Support Packages. He shared with us:

"I come to the Centre because it is a place to meet with people, talk, and unwind. We understand the issues we are each going through. It sets my mind free to have these connections. It is therapeutic to socialise and take your mind away from difficult situations.

The Centre also helps me with Support Packages. You may think that the Support Packages aren't very much, but for us it goes a long way. And the phone top-ups help me connect with my family and friends.

The Centre is my number one helper. They help me financially, with getting toiletries and basics, and signposting and connecting with other organisations. They check on me and my wellbeing.

People who support the Centre are helping so many people beyond their wildest dreams. It is the reason that some of us are still here. Donors to the Centre are saving lives. Thank you to the donors for making this the place to come."
